I find myself drawn to this old tune every year about this time. It reminds me that Easter Sunday is not just one day in April (sometimes in late March). The Easter Season is not just the 50 days we celebrate in the church, lasting through 7 weeks of Easter leading up to Pentecost on June 12. Every day is Easter morning because the first Easter morning changes everything.

Read again some of the words in the song. "the past is over and gone, good-bye guilt, good-bye fear, good riddance, my new life has begun, God's in charge, spread the word, yesterday I was bored and lonely, but today look and see, I belong to the Easter people, life's exciting to me." Everything has changed because of that Son Rise long ago. Has your new life begun, today, and tomorrow, and the day after that? Do we live as Easter People, rejoicing in the Good News that, for us, everything has changed?

It's so easy to leave Easter behind. The press of work, family, health concerns, war and the economy and weather that snows in April and flooding and wet fields and you can add to the list. Sometimes it seems as if Friday lasts forever and Easter never happened. We live the life of Thomas who did not see the risen Jesus that first Easter evening and he was not convinced until he saw Jesus who said to him, "Do you believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those (all of us) who have not seen me and yet have come to believe." John 20:29

Jesus appeared to Mary at the tomb, the disciples and Thomas in the upper room, two who walked the road back to Emmaus, and when Jesus appears, everything changes. The grief and gloom of Good Friday is washed away in the joy of Easter. The Spirit of God works among us and reveals to us the risen Christ in Word and Sacrament, worship and fellowship, service and sacrifice for the Lord and for the neighbor. We will see Jesus in the people around us who need us to share the Good News that we have received from the Lord. We will see Jesus in every person who has spiritual and physical needs to which we can respond. We live in the promise that we will see Jesus, raised from the dead, so that Every Morning, for us and the people we meet, is Easter Morning. Go Spread The Good News That Jesus Christ is Risen Indeed! And everything is changed, everything is made new! Now and Forever!
